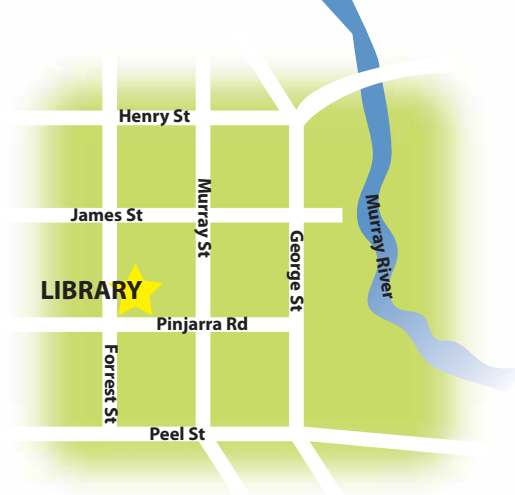


Rhyme Time

Welcome to the Murray Library Service

Library membership

Membership to the Murray Library is free to all residents of Western Australia.

In order to borrow items, all you need to do is show us valid identification with your current address and complete the membership application form. You will be issued with a card, and you will be able to utilise all library services and facilities straight away.

There is no minimum age for joining, but those under the age of 18 years require the signature of their parent or guardian.

Library cards are your responsibility and the library should be advised when cards are lost or stolen so that you are not held responsible for unauthorised borrowings on your card. Lost cards incur a replacement charge, unless a WA Police report number can be provided.

Borrowing details

- Library cards should be presented at each visit in order to borrow items.
- A Library card enables you to borrow up to eight items at a time.
- Two each of DVDs, videos, CD-ROMs and music CDs can be borrowed at a time per card.
- All items are on loan for three weeks, with the exception of 'High Demand' items. You may renew by phone or online as long as the items have not been requested by another member.
- High Demand items are items with three or more borrowers waiting and can only be loaned for two weeks at a time.
- A depreciated charge applies for lost and damaged items, along with an Administration Fee. This fee is also charged for very overdue items. (More than three weeks overdue)
