GATEWAY FOR ADVENTURE + REGIONAL TRAIN MUSEUM

- Upgrade of the Paterson Road/South West Highway/Pinjarra-Williams Road is subject to further detailed design.
- The location of the pedestrian and vehicle crossovers are to be confirmed subsequent to detailed design of the Paterson Road / South West Highway/Pinjarra-Williams Rd intersection.
- Reconfiguration of internal car park design required to ensure parking closer to the Community Garden and Men's Shed and proposed car parking or the internal road network does not impede on leased areas.
- Undertake further discussions/investigations in the future as to potential opportunities for expansion of the Men's Shed and Pinjarra Community Garden through realignment of leased area boundaries.
