Celebrate Mother's Day in style with a special High Tea experience (including a complimentary glass of wine). Two sittings are available. Bookings are essential.

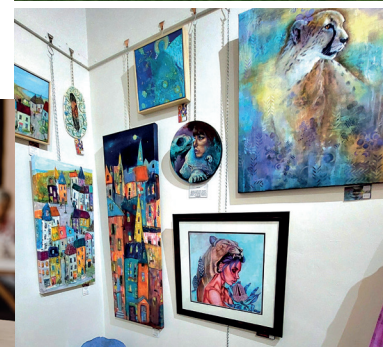

### 1. The Church Collective

Home to a large etching press, members explore techniques from relief and intaglio to screen-printing and monoprints. Visitors to the Pinjarra Art Trail are welcome to experience printmaking in action, learn about the processes behind the work, and even get involved through regular hands-on activities.

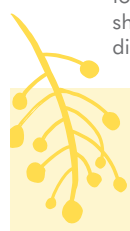
