Proposed 1000m Landscape Screen Planting (3 staggered Rows)

Row 1 -Mid Storey Planting (Staggered @ 3m centres)

• Acacia cochlearis	3 m
• Acacia cyclops	3 m
• Acacia truncata	3 m
• Eucalyptus kruseana	3 m
• Eucalyptus foecunda	5 m
• Hakea laurina	6m
• Hakea varia (Variable Leaved Hakea)	4 m
• Melaleuca lateritia	3 m
• Melaleuca megacephala	5 m
• Melaleuca radula	3 m
• Olearia axillaris (Little Smokie)	3 m
• Regelia ciliata	3 m
• Regelia inops	4 m
• Leptospermum scoparium (manuka)	2-5m
• Eucalytus erythroneme (Red Flowered Mallee)	6m

Row 2 -Shrub Buffer (Staggered @ 2m centres)

Acacia huegelii	1m
Acacia Lasiocarpa	2m
Acacia dentifera	2-3m
Melaleuca scabra	2m
Melaleuca systema	2m
Kunzea recuva (purple Kunzea)	2m
Hakea varia	1-4m

KEY

A variety of tubestock and 140mm pots, subject to availability. Planting will be carried out with low shrubs closest to the outer/ interface; mid-storey in the middle; and trees behind inside. Overburden can sit behind the planting screen, on the extraction side, to improve screening.
