ABORIGINAL CULTURAL HERITAGE – PROPOSED SCHEME AMENDMENT – LOT 39 LAKES ROAD, NORTH DANDALUP

Thank you for your inquiry dated 15 May 2025 seeking comment from the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (DPLH), Aboriginal Heritage Conservation Team, regarding the proposed scheme amendment for Lot 39 Lakes Road, North Dandalup.

A review of the Register of Places and Objects, as well as the DPLH Aboriginal Heritage Database, concludes that the subject area intersects with the actual boundary of Aboriginal Registered Site Dandalup River (ID 27937).

Please be advised that the scheme amendment, in itself, does not require approval under the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 1972* (AHA), however any future works that intersect with the Aboriginal Site may require approval. Proponents should contact DPLH to request advice regarding the proposed works and any intersection that may occur.

Furthermore, I wish to advise:

- the scheme amendment approval does not impact the Aboriginal heritage of the area;
- it should be emphasised to the proponents that the scheme amendment approval does not count as approval under the AHA.
