

1. Policy Intention

To ensure that, where the acquisition of land is required for road realignment or road reconstruction, the affected landowners will be dealt with fairly and efficiently and in accordance with all relevant Acts and Regulations.

2. Policy

- 2.1** Where it is necessary and funds are allocated in budget to undertake road works that require the acquisition of private land, officers will –
- Formally advise the relevant landowners and seek written agreement for the proposed acquisition;
 - Obtain at least two written market valuations, where there is significant impact on land, for subject land that considers any injurious affection matters.
- 2.2** That upon receipt of written agreement and subject to budgeted funding commence the legal processes to effect the transfer of land ownership to the Shire of Murray up to the value of the lesser market valuation and reasonable injurious affection matters in accordance with law. The acquisition of any portion of land shall be undertaken as expeditiously as possible.
